Constituency PPC says closure "an act of vandalism."

Nick Boles, the new Conservative Prospective Parliamentary Candidate for Grantham and Stamford, has attacked the proposed closure of Rippingale Post Office.

Nick Boles, who was selected last Friday, is due to visit the village tomorrow (Saturday October 13) to talk to sub-postmaster Simon Deane, to customers and to members of the group campaigning to keep the PO open.

A large crowd of villagers is expected to wait to meet him and the sitting MP Quentin Davies.

(Please note - Mr Davies is due in the village at 9.30 am and Mr. Boles will arrive AFTER he has left - they will NOT appear together).

Today Nick Boles lent his full support to the Rippingale campaign. He said "Rippingale Post Office provides a vital service to local people, especially the elderly and those who don't drive. Its closure would be an act of vandalism. We must stop it."
